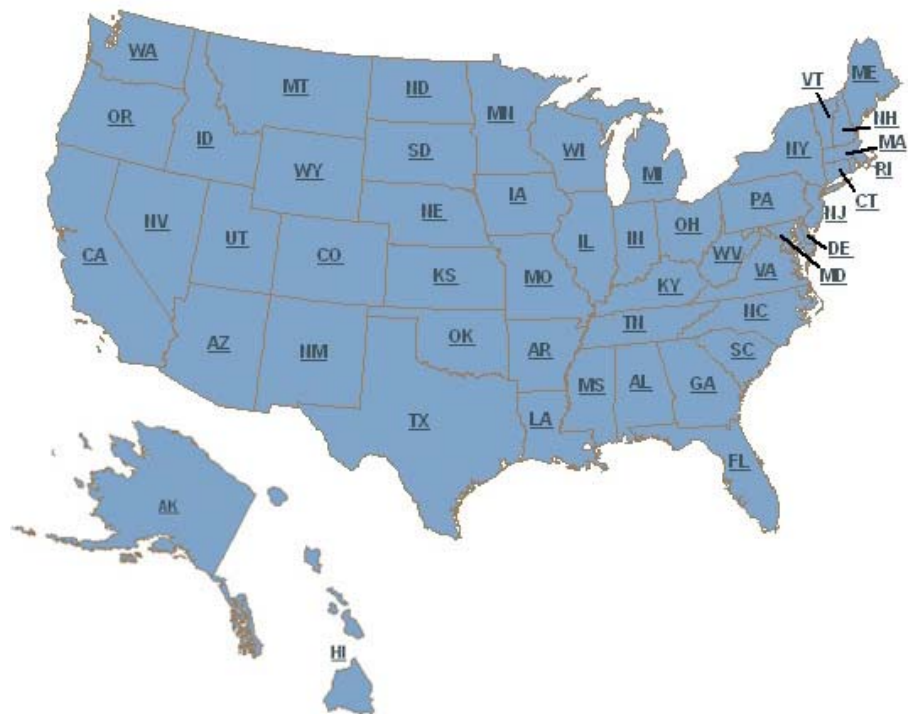
### Subsidized Housing Data

Federally assisted housing provides homes for millions of families and seniors throughout the country. The Trust plays a leading role in providing information about the federally assisted rental housing stock so that policymakers and community advocates can know where affordable housing is at risk and which properties should be targeted for preservation.

- Properties with expiring **project-based Section 8** contracts (includes mortgage details if the mortgage is FHA-insured)
- Properties with active USDA **Section 515** loans
- Properties financed with **Low Income Housing Tax Credits**
- Properties with active **Section 202/811** loans
